## Area Positions Vacant (as per announcements above) - brief position descriptions:

<u>Vice Chairperson</u> Clean time: 2 years Term: 1 year

The primary responsibility of the area committee vice chairperson is the coordination of the area subcommittees. The area vice chairperson keeps in regular touch with the chairpersons of each subcommittee to stay informed of their projects and problems, attending subcommittee meetings whenever possible. If disputes arise within a subcommittee or between subcommittees, the ASC vice chairperson helps find solutions to them. The vice chairperson works closely with subcommittee chairpersons when they prepare their annual reports and budget proposals. The vice chairperson is also responsible to assist the chairperson in conducting area committee meetings and to conduct ASC meetings in the chairperson's absence.

Policy Chair Clean time: 3 years Term: 1 year

The GCASC Policy Chair advises the GCASC about policy issues during the course of the area meeting and often clarifies guidelines -- therefore is required to have a reasonable knowledge of the manual. They coordinate the drafting of new policy for consideration by the GCASC and maintains and updates these Guidelines, including the policy log.

Public Relations Chair Clean time: 3 years Term: 1 year

The general mission of your public relations subcommittee is to inform addicts and others in the community of the availability of recovery in Narcotics Anonymous. Service provided by the PR subcommittee vary widely from area to area. The simplest kind of PR project is the production and distribution of fliers throughout the community announcing that NA is available and that more information can be had either by calling the local NA information phoneline or by attending an NA meeting.

RCM Regional Committee Clean time: 2 years Term: 2 years

Member

RCM's keep their areas in touch with the larger world of NA by providing information on activities in neighbouring areas, functions being sponsored by the regional committee, reports relevant to subcommittee affairs, and important issues being discussed at various levels of service.

The RCM is expected to attend as many Group Conscience meetings within the GCASC as possible. and to email copies of GCASC minutes to ARSC Alternate Delegate.

Committee Member

Clean time: 18 months Term: 2 years (+2 years as RCM)

Traditionally this service position is one of learning to take on the RCM role and supporting the current RCM in their tasks. This means that the position involves a four year commitment - the first 2 years serving as the RCM Alt then going on to complete a two year term as the RCM. During the term you will be expected to attend the GCASC meetings and administration meetings monthly; supply a report; attend the Regional Committee Meeting with the RCM toward the end of their term; and be available to subcommittees and groups to access resources. It is advantageous to have a working knowledge of the service structure and the stability to complete the time commitment to full term. The Alt RCM is required to attend a minimum of two virtual ARSC meetings per year for training purposes and to grasp a knowledge of how the ARSC operates.

Convention Chair Clean time: 3 years Term: 1 year

The purpose of the Gold Coast Area Convention is to celebrate spiritual recovery, encourage unity and generate funds to support area activities.

The Convention Chairperson's role is to form and coordinate a subcommittee to plan, prepare and facilitate the GCASC's annual convention. They then work with the elected convention committee to organise the Gold Coast Area convention by coordinating and chairing regular committee meetings. Some additional duties include: Facilitating and attending regular subcommittee meetings, liaising with venue operators and presenting monthly reports to the GCASC.

Ad Hoc Chair Clean time 1 year

Adhoc committees may be formed from time to time by the GCASC for special purposes outside the duties of existing committees and subcommittees. These may be formed to perform service workshops, take surveys or produce newsletters or service related papers.

## **Admin and Sub Committee Reports**

#### Chairperson

GCANA Chair & RCM (acting) report to Area – August 2022

An admin committee meeting was held on Monday August 15. From this, only the discussion of 'the squares' was brought up as put forward by Wednesday night GSR (though not minuted!). As NA is a not for profit

organisation, the Secretary suggested all was needed was to supply a copy of our 'Constitution'. As I was to attend an informal meeting of RCMs the following weekend, I would ask at that forum.

From the informal meeting of RCMs, what is deemed to report to area is

The feedback on the idea of the squares was seemingly laughed at as this had been brought up time and again with the resolution of the Region that it was not feasible – I was directed to the most recent document regarding this from the Legal Incorporation Workgroup (LIW).

There is to be a vote on the cycle change from 2 to 3 years for the Narcotics Anonymous World Service (NAWS) with the following main points of argument:

For - reduce the cost to NAWS for delegates to attend

Against – actions are slow enough as it is and this would only slow it down

Eg the action on 'Him' in the literature.

FYI – One state in the US (California) borrowed money from the Trump administration which is now in Court regarding paying it back. This is to be brought up for discussion around anonymity and the possible prospect of the subpoena of emails eg from the RSC of NA at home based in Australia.

Due to a NAWS'announced price rise increase, plus other rising costs we will be raising the costs of some items on the 1stof October 2022. Sponsorship, Steps working guide and JFT going up from \$17 to \$18, other booksfrom\$17 to \$20, key tags and chips 70 cents to 80 cents, pamphlets and bronze medallions stay the same price but with the tri-plate medallions rising from \$33 to \$40. I have liaised with the Regional Treasurer for flights to the Regional Committee meeting next weekend and ask, re policy for the Area Treasurer, for 2 x \$150/day = \$300 for expenses.

## Secretary/ Webservant

As reported by the Australian region, it is not feasible for areas or groups to use card payment methods such as Square and Zeller readers. Every provider requires an ABN. The only way this can happen is by the area or group gaining registration as a not-for-profit organisation with the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission. There are extensive reporting and compliance requirements associated with getting and retaining registration and hence costs involved.

An option which is being used by some groups in Brisbane is a Paypal Money Pool. Here is an example of how it could work for Gold Coast area sub-committees or groups:

- The sub-committee or group requests the area treasurer to create a BOQ account for them within the area facility, with two to sign and oversight by the area treasurer. Most of the relevant sub-committees already have one;
- The sub-committee or group gets a \*. goldcoast@na.org.au email account established, with the area treasurer as a recovery email address.
- The sub-committee or group creates a paypal account using this email address, then establishes a Money Pool with the BOQ account as the only destination of funds allowed.

- A QR code is established, which when scanned, leads to the Paypal Money Pool payments page.
- Members wishing to fund flow scan the QR code, then after entering their Paypal credentials, nominate the amount they wish to pay.
- There are no Paypal or BOQ costs involved.
- During the 2021-2022 financial around 50% of all Australians made Paypal payments.

# Narcotics Anonymous. Australian Regional Service Committee

Update on Squares as of 1 December 2021

From the Legal Incorporation Workgroup - to all RCMs

Below is an update on the potential implementation of Square readers for Cashless 7th Tradition for Narcotics Anonymous.

#### Background - NA's Legal Structure in Australia

Service Level	Structure	ABN

#### Information previously provided by Square:

An Association must have an ABN to sign up for a Square Account. There is currently no way of registering a Square Account under the name of a Meeting or Area without an ABN.

If NA were to setup a Square Account it must be setup under the RSBoA Inc as it is the service level with the ABN.

This would involve the Management Committee of the RSBoA Inc taking legal responsibility for those Squares.

#### There were two solutions offered:

- 1. The Management Committee of the RSBoA manages the setup and allocation of all of the Squares for Narcotics Anonymous Areas and Meetings.
- 2. Areas manage the setup and allocation of Squares for the Area and the Meetings within it using Locations.

For either solution, all monies collected from the Squares would have to go into the ARSC Bank Account held with NAB, due to it being the account that the ABN is linked to.

For the second solution, there would be a cost of \$420 per location per year. If 18 physical Areas (not including NA @ Home) were to participate, this would involve an annual cost to Region of \$7.560. In addition, each Square costs \$59.00.

#### The LIW approached Square on November 30 and December 1 to obtain some additional information:

Information on the Square website indicated that it is possible to link different bank accounts to each Location. The LIW asked if NA were to setup Areas as Locations, could the bank accounts for each Area be linked instead.

#### Square gave the following responses:

- Under Australian AUSTRAC Compliance obligations, all linked bank accounts must share an ABN with the business
  operating the Square account.
- This will not change any time soon as this is government regulation rather than Square policy.

The LIW then sought to clarify this further, and asked if this is due to the different service levels of NA being classed as different legal entities?

#### Square gave the following response:

That is correct. Different bank accounts are able to be used but they must match the ABN that's on the account. Some businesses manage multiple stores under a master ABN but then route to different bank accounts which is fine on our front - but routing to bank accounts unrelated to the master ABN is against our terms.

#### The LIW then sought to understand if a master arrangement could be applied to NA.

#### Square gave the following response:

Associations must have ABNs regardless of their status of being incorporated or unincorporated, so unfortunately this still appears to be a use case we aren't able to support without individual ABNs for the meetings.
