<u>Policy Chair</u>	Clean time: 3 years	Term: 1 year

The GCASC Policy Chair advises the GCASC about policy issues during the course of the area meeting and often clarifies guidelines - therefore is required to have a reasonable knowledge of the manual. They coordinate the drafting of new policy for consideration by the GCASC and maintains and updates these Guidelines, including the policy log.

<u>Alt-RCM</u>	Clean time: 18 Months	Term: 2 Years (+ 2 as RCM)
----------------	-----------------------	----------------------------

Traditionally this service position is one of learning to take on the RCM role and supporting the current RCM in their tasks. This means that the position involves a four year commitment - the first 2 years serving as the RCM Alt then going on to complete a two year term as the RCM. During the term you will be expected to attend the GCASC meetings and administration meetings monthly; supply a report; attend the Regional Committee Meeting with the RCM toward the end of their term; and be available to subcommittees and groups to access resources. It is advantageous to have a working knowledge of the service structure and the stability to complete the time commitment to full term. The Alt RCM is required to attend a minimum of two virtual ARSC meetings per year for training purposes and to grasp a knowledge of how the ARSC operates.

From A Guide to Local Services: ‘The general mission of your public relations subcommittee is to inform addicts and others in the community of the availability of recovery in Narcotics Anonymous. Service provided by the PR subcommittee vary widely from area to area. The simplest kind of PR project is the production and distribution of fliers throughout the community announcing that NA is available and that more information can be had either by calling the local NA information phoneline or by attending an NA meeting. As PR subcommittees become better developed, they often conduct public meetings for community members, distribute public service announcements to local radio and television stations, and respond to public media inquiries. Some PR subcommittees develop separate working groups called CPC panels (short for cooperation with the professional community) to focus especially on the NA community’s relations with local treatment professionals. The Public Relations Handbook, is available from the FSO or by writing the World Service Office, provides detailed information on conducting a wide range of projects designed to increase community awareness of narcotics Anonymous.’ The GCASC PR chair is also responsible for the production of the GCASC meetings list and the GCASC contacts for the National NA 1300 number. The National NA 1300 number is to be included on GCASC meetings lists. Any changes required in the meeting list (at a group level) should be given to the PR chair for updating. The PR chair -should also forward any changes onto the RCM so they can update the website.

<u>Activities Chair</u>	Clean time: 2 Years	Term: 1 Year

From *A Guide to Local Services*: ‘Dances, picnics, campouts, special speaker meetings – these events are put on by area activities subcommittees. Activities like these can provide a greater sense of community for the local NA Fellowship and produce additional area income. It should always be kept in mind, however, that these functions are designed to enhance NA’s primary purpose, not to replace group contributions in funding area services.’

The activities subcommittee is responsible for being:

Additionally, Unity Days, BBQ’s, cabaret nights, talent quests (red faces), trivia nights, surf competitions, sporting events, , bowling nights, dances and other unity building events are possibilities to incorporate into the yearly calendar of events that can be managed by this committee at their discretion or if directed by the fellowship. The Activities Subcommittee may also be requested to support workshops by providing catering and other activities as requested. Responsible management of NA funds is vitally important in this role and reports including itemized and receipted financial transactions are to be supplied for each event. It is understood that these unity building events are not mandated to raise funds, however it is agreed that an attempt to breakeven financially is met as per our 11th Concept.

## VERBAL REPORT

RCM report March 2025.

I was unable to attend the Sydney face to face region due to the cyclone. I found myself really disappointed as I haven't missed a service commitment since I became the RCM of the Gold Coast fellowship, left with no power and no internet coverage was a massive disruption and something that I had to see as a completely powerless situation, flights were cancelled from the Coolangatta airport.

I also missed the cancellation date for any refund or reimbursement of what I paid out of my own money, from the hotel I booked, and the fact that I booked through Expedia online. Even though the cyclone was blowing and hectic I was still adamant to try and get online as the ARSC sorted out a zoom link so off I went in my car and found a place in Southport near the community centre on the Saturday morning and by my higher powers grace I connected and was marked as present not even five minutes later the connection was lost for the rest of the day, looked around at how the storm was and decided I got to get home is this really important. The next morning, I was informed by our chair of the GC area [REDACTED] that there was a dial up connection to the region meeting that we could hear but not see so off we went again in the hectic cyclonic rain and wind to do our best to be part of the meeting, after a butane stove boiled coffee, we sat again in our car as I prayed that I could participate, was a real struggle but at 10:00 just in time for nominations the dial up linked worked, and from an utterly powerless situation feeling disconnected from everything we heard a voice from the vice chair of region [REDACTED] can u hear us, the gratitude that I felt from this was truly overwhelming and I was quite moved that even though our home was being battered by the extreme weather just hearing other people and other recovering addicts was a wonderful feeling. Two nominations that I was present for was the assistant treasurer, [REDACTED] I had some questions to ask that I had already had ready to go prior to region in my notes a lot of questions were actually asked about his motives and what was his reasoning behind his nomination, for transparency reasons he was the person who had caused a lot of issues with untrue remarks at the last region meeting and why we needed a review of our constitution, our consensus based voting procedure is such a constructive way for us to endorse trusted servants giving everybody present the time to voice any questions or concerns after quite a lengthy discussion, through consensus the position was not endorsed. The next nomination was [REDACTED] for the H&I working group chair, no dramas she was elected, due to her experience and understanding of the role in which she nominated for. The last bit was a IT subcommittee discussion that I was also present for, more information and a proposal will be tabled at the next region, the storm picked up quite considerably and we lost all connection again. My next reports that will be from region will be from the minutes that were recorded from the secretary they haven't come out yet as there is quite a lot of information for the admin team of the ARSC to go through, I will do my best to report what I can over the coming months.

Expenses spent for my accommodation was \$457.53 I also paid for the NA today chair who was sharing accommodation she was going to reimburse me her half of the booking when we arrived out of her allowance, so the total that I am wandering if it's possible to get a reimbursement from our area is \$228.75. I have a proposal that I can table if needed and the receipt for the booking if anyone would like to see it.
